1. Complete the Extended Day For Extended Funds Voucher Application
  - \* Don't forget the legal guardian signature
  - \* Don't forget your child's social security number & date of birth
2. If you are new to the Recreation Council's Voucher programs, you are required to have a DMH Regional Center Service Coordinator, a SB 40 Board Service Coordinator, or a physician complete the Verification of Eligibility Form
3. Be sure to include the additional documentation:
  - \* Employment verification for both parents/guardians with 2019 W-2
  - \* A letter from each employer on letterhead stationery which includes the Employer ID number and stating the employee's work hours and where the employee is working (virtual from home or in the office).
