Join Randi for a morning hike. You will be required to follow Randi in your own vehicle to the trail head. Caravan will depart from the Recreation Building parking lot at 10:00am each day. You must call the front office to sign up!

Monday - 10:00AM - Rattlesnake Hike: - Get some fresh air and a fantastic view of Squam, Winnepesaukee, and the surrounding mountains with an easy to moderate hike up Rattlesnake Mountain in Center Sandwich, NH. GORGEOUS! Sturdy shoes and layers are recommended.

Monday- 2:00pm - Open Craft Room: Limited to 8 people mask are required. Meet in the craft room for your choice of activity. Prices vary per craft.

Tuesday- 10:00AM – Walter Newton Hike: Enjoy a hike through Walter/Newton Natural Area Trail. Please wear appropriate clothing. **Walter/Newton Natural Area** Trail is a 1.5 mile moderately trafficked loop trail located near **Plymouth**, New Hampshire that features a waterfall and is good for all skill levels.

Tuesday-2:00pm - CANDY BAR BINGO: - Limited to 8 people and mask are required. Meet Randi in the multi-purpose room where we will play

Wednesday- 10:00am - Stinson Hike: Stinson Mountain located just north of the beautiful small town of Rumney, NH is a well-known local hike. The hike, only 3.6 miles is a great family hike due the trail's easy to moderate pitches. The trail stays Class 1 throughout the hike and the views on top are great for the minimal effort needed. The views from the top of Stinson Mountain are excellent, especially to the south towards Mt. Cardigan and the Lakes Region. There is also a spur path to the southwest that gives views of Stinson Lake.

Thursday 10:00am – Mt. Cardigan - Join Randi for a **MODERATE** hike up Mt. Cardigan. Mount Cardigan's 3,121-foot treeless granite summit affords outstanding views of west central New Hampshire, with a panorama that includes Mount Monadnock and the White Mountains, Camel's Hump in Vermont, and Pleasant Mountain in Maine.
