CAMPING: This private facility has campsites with electricity (30a and 50a), water hookups and covered stalls. We will be on the sawmill side of the camp with approximately 30 campsites available and more primitive camping if needed. There are modern restrooms with hot showers, laundry facilities and 2 RV dump stations. Dogs on leash. Horses must be in a stall. Negative Coggins Required.

CAMPING RESERVATIONS: Contact the facility directly for camping reservations. Their phone is 931-962-1790. Horses are required to be in a stall so be sure to include a reservation for each horse. The preferred camping areas for NATRC competitors is in the Sawmill side. Please let them know you will be competing with NATRC. All camping is first come, first serve.

RIDER LIMIT: 60 **DISTANCE:** Novice & CP will do approximately 18 miles/day; Open approximately 27 miles/day.

TRAIL TERRAIN: The trails are picturesque in the Cumberland Mountains of Tennessee including hills, fields and wooded forests. Expect rocks and some gravel- shoes are recommended. This ride is open to all horses, ponies, and mules (mounts), age 4 (actual foaling date) & over and to all riders age 10 and over. Be prepared for all weather possibilities during the ride.

FRIDAY SCHEDULE:

CHECK-IN: 12 **VET-IN:** 1 PM **RIDE BRIEFING:** Due to COVID19 restrictions there will be no ride briefing. Maps will be posted online in advance of the ride with copies in the rider packets. Contact Ride Manager or Secretary with questions.

NEW COMPETITOR BRIEFING: Mentors will meet one-on-one with new competitors. Complete weekend schedule available will be in rider packets.

COVID PROTOCOLS: We will be following the CDC's guidelines for COVID19. In addition to observing mask and social distancing protocols other precautions will be included in the riders' packets.

MEALS: Due to COVID19 restrictions, there will be no group dinners. All meals are at participants campsite

SPECIAL NOTES: Support and mentors available for 1st-time competitors. The FREE annual NATRC membership for new non-members remains available. Learn more at www.natrc.org. Riders must be minimum 10 (ten) years old. Junior riders under 18 are REQUIRED to wear an approved equestrian helmet.

From Nashville or Chattanooga: I24 to Exit 127 onto 64 West, Drive 17 miles, Turn left onto Hwy 16 South, Drive 7 miles, Turn right into Circle E Guest Ranch

From Birmingham: 165 N to Exit 14 onto Hwy 64E, Drive 65 miles to Hwy 16, Turn right onto Hwy 16 south, Drive 7 miles, Turn right into circle E Guest Ranch
