- TRAIL & TERRAIN: Rolling hills, limited gravel. Shoes or boots recommended.
- DISTANCE: Novice & CP: ~19 mile/day Open: ~26 miles/day
- CAMPING: Primitive. Water available in camp. Vault and Port-a-Lets. Horses tied to trailer, high lines or secured portable corrals. Negative Coggins required.
- MEALS: On your own. Volunteers fed Saturday – Sunday lunch; Ride management fed all weekend.
