Complete weekend schedule will be available at check-in on Friday.

Special Notes: Saturday riders will be across the French Broad, you will wind through the vineyards and explore the private part of the Estate. Sunday you will have the opportunity for a photo opp. in front of the Biltmore House on horseback. Helmets are required. Getting into the French Broad with your horse is forbidden. No smoking on trails. No open fires.

If you plan to arrive before Friday, you'll need to call BEC 828-225-1454 for early entry onto the grounds.

Directions: From I-40, use exit 50, follow signs to Biltmore Estate. Stay in far-left lane. Traffic can be VERY heavy in this area at times. From I-26, take I-40 E., use exit 50, same as above. Entrance to Biltmore Estate is on the left. Follow signs **BEC** (Biltmore Equestrian Center) to camp. Once you enter the front gate of the Estate it is 10-15 min to get to camp. Speed limit is very slow, due to tourist and geese traffic.
