Judging done on the trail with you AND your horse competing as a team!
AWARDS presented at end of day's ride (3 divisions: youth/adult/experienced)

Stalls, cabins, and campsites are available for those wanting to stay overnight. 15 miles of sand-based trails, some along Tombigbee

Doing 2 one-day rides gives you a real opportunity to work with your horse and see the progress you both can make. Leaves should be at full Fall colors with cool temps.
