**\*\*CHRISTMAS COLLECTION EXPLAINED...** The collection taken up at our Christmas Mass (December 24<sup>th</sup>) is NOT part of the "ordinary income" of the parish, as are the Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation. 20% of the Christmas collection goes to the pastor as part of his salary and 20% goes to the diocese to assist the poor parishes of our diocese to support themselves. The remaining 60% stays with our parish and is exempt from the customary 16% diocesan tax to which the "ordinary income" is subjected.

**\*\*CHRISTMAS FLOWERS & DECORATIONS...** If you wish to contribute towards these, there is an envelope in your boxes. If you do not use church envelopes for your weekly support of the parish, there are envelopes for this purpose on the small tables by the doors of the church. Donations can be made "in honor of" families and/or individuals OR "in memory of" deceased loved ones OR as a "gift" from a family or individual. Please PRINT all names CLEARLY on the envelope. All names will appear in the January, 2019 bulletin. It is, however, important to make your donation EARLY so that we can determine how much we can spend on flowers & decorations.

Saturday, December 1<sup>st</sup>, 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM
- Vendors may set up on Thursday, November 29, from 8 AM – noon, and on Friday, November 30<sup>th</sup>, beginning at 8:00 AM & continuing until the bazaar opens at 2:00 PM (other times by appointment)
- Raffle ticket returns can take place right up to the time of the drawing on Saturday, December 1<sup>st</sup> at 2:00 PM. Tickets must be accompanied with payment in order to be eligible.
- Baked goods can be brought to the Parish Hall on Friday, November 30<sup>th</sup> beginning at 8:00 AM and continuing until closing time at 5:00 PM. And again on Saturday until 10:00 AM.
