

2020 COVID-19 Guidelines and Rules for Lakeside Arena

COVID-19 Guidelines

As a youth and adult noncontact sport, the following COVID-19 Guidelines must be adhered to when competing and/or attending our competitions. In addition, all Federal, State, and local laws that may be applicable must be followed. Management reserves the right to change the guidelines when/if it is necessary. Failure to follow guidelines may result in expulsion from the show grounds.

The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus. (See www.cdc.gov)

If you are planning to come to Lakeside Arena, you **must** be able to assure management that neither you, nor anyone in your household:

1. Has tested positive or has been presumed positive for COVID-19 at any time during the past 14 days
 2. Has been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine at any time during the past 14 days
 3. Has been in close physical contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has been presumed positive for COVID-19, during the past 14 days
 4. Is subject to a quarantine order or a recommendation of a healthcare professional that, in either case, would make it inadvisable to attend a public event or competition.
 5. Has, within the past 24 hours, exhibited any of the following symptoms: fever of 100.4 or greater, cough, shortness of breath.
- Social distancing guidelines must be followed at all times. Current guidelines call for a 6' minimum spacing between individuals. Do NOT gather in groups.
 - **Wash your hands often** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 70% alcohol. The use of gloves is encouraged, but not required.

- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- We REQUIRE wearing a cloth face cover or mask when in public or close contact situations at Lakeside Arena, per [KYHealthyatWork](#) Requirements – Horse Shows. Rider can take mask off during competition or leave on without penalty showing.
- Please frequently clean and disinfect all tack, equipment, and surfaces that others may come in contact with. This includes tack trunks, reins, halters, grooming items, lead ropes, and other common items that others may come in contact with during event attendance.
- Please use trash receptacles, so that staff does not have to come in contact with contaminated items that are not discarded properly. **PLEASE DO NOT LITTER!**
- All competitors and attendees are responsible for monitoring their own personal and family health prior too, during, and after attending a competition.
- Trainers will be held responsible for the conduct and adherence to the rules and guidelines set forth during the competition. Trainers and/or barns are subject to expulsion from the grounds if guidelines are not followed. Please discuss with each individual in your group the importance of following rules and the direction of horse show staff and security personnel.
- Until further notice the competition is open only to Trainers, Riders, Grooms, Owners, Competition Staff, and parent/ guardian attending as a minor's guardian. Children not competing should stay home.
- Until Further notice NO Spectators, NO extended family or Friends. If you are NOT directly involved with a horse or pony competing, you are NOT allowed on competition grounds.
- Any barn or trainer found in violation of current non-essential personnel guidelines may be expelled from the grounds.
- All vehicles and trailers entering the competition grounds will be subject to

being stopped at the front entrance of Lakeside Arena for inspection and proof of admittance.

- **All vehicles arriving will stop at arrival check point. All people entering facility will be required to have a signed new COVID-19 waiver on file with Lakeside Arena. Please download, print, sign and complete waivers from our website www.lakesidearena.org or www.horseshowing.com to help expedite the arrival process.**
- Dogs must be kept under control and confined or leashed at all times. Dogs can potentially come in contact with multiple people if loose on competition grounds. They must be confined and/or leashed away from the general public. If a dog is found loose on competition grounds, the owner and dog will be expelled from the grounds immediately.
- Please keep time spent on the competition grounds to a minimum, in order to limit contact and exposure to yourself and other attendees.
- **Office Procedure:** We will be accepting online entries ONLY. All entries will need to be made online at www.horseshowing.com. This is in compliance with [KYHealthyatWork](#) Requirements – Horse Shows. **NO PAPER ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. PRE - ENTRIES ARE DUE WEDNESDAY AT 6:00 pm PRIOR to the weekend of the horse show.** All entries received after this time will be considered a LATE ENTRY and a \$25.00 late fee per horse entered will be assessed. All entries are to be done per Trainer/ Agent if you are showing by yourself you are considered the agent. Horseshowing.com will be charging a per horse subscription fee. Horseshowing.com is very user friendly. Any questions with entries and setting up horseshowing.com can be directed to **Lynn Johnson (859)396-9633**. All check-ins and check-outs will only be done by Trainer/Agent to help stay in compliance with our COVID-19 guidelines. Trainers/ Agent will collect all clients' checks and pay bills at checkout. At check-in, one open check will hold entries per Trainer/Agent. Trainer sheets (download from www.lakesidearena.org) **must be completed and turned in check-in** for correct allocation of tack stall and/or extra shavings. At check-in and check-out, please have all your paperwork ready so that we can have an efficient process. Please bring your own pen and mask (REQUIRED) to check-in/check-out to help eliminate any possible cross

contamination. ALL Stalls and/or Shavings orders must be ordered by texting **Bruce Brown (859) 489-4885**. Text must include your name, number of stalls needed and number of extra shavings.

- Barns should designate **one** person to handle the entire barn's interface with the show office: ideally the Trainer and/or Agent. No more than one person will be allowed at show office window (which will have a Plexiglas divider) at a time. A **6'** distance between people waiting in line will be enforced. **Lakeside Arena staff members are the only people allowed in office. Masks are REQUIRED for any interaction at the Show Office to help keep our staff safe.**
- Please do not crowd the in gate area. Only Trainer and exhibitor on horse allowed at in gate area. Everyone must be following social **6'** distancing.
- All courses will be posted on a board but also will be posted on **Lakeside Arena Facebook** page to eliminate congestion.
- Parking Area, Campgrounds and stalls should be set up so that all exhibitors are at least 6' apart.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout Lakeside Arena. Please use appropriately.
- **Lakeside Arena will not have a concession stand at this time.**
- **All persons must read and sign a COVID 19 waiver before entrance to Lakeside Arena. This will be able be downloaded electronically on our webpage. www.lakesidearena.org. and horseshowing.com**

Thank you in advanced for your compliance and assistance in keeping our grounds at Lakeside Arena, our Lakeside family and staff as safe as possible.
