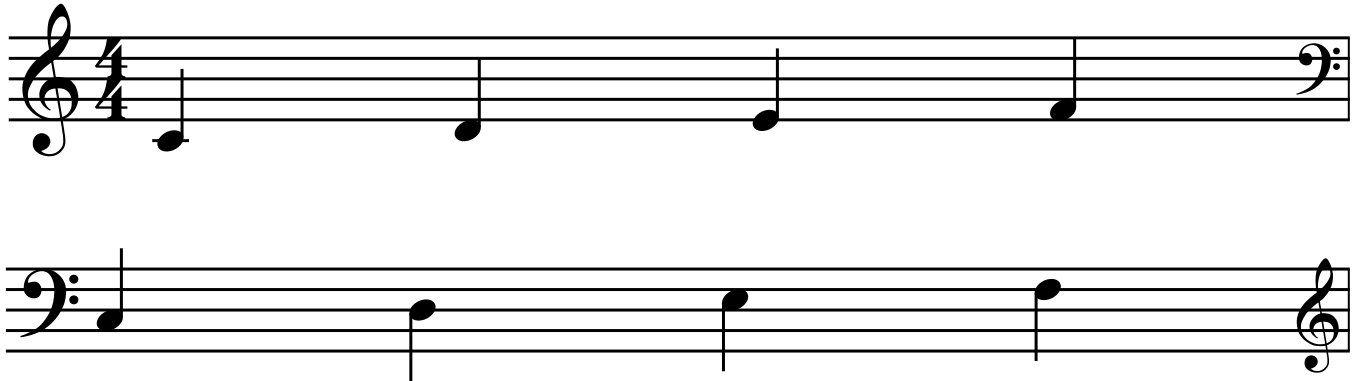


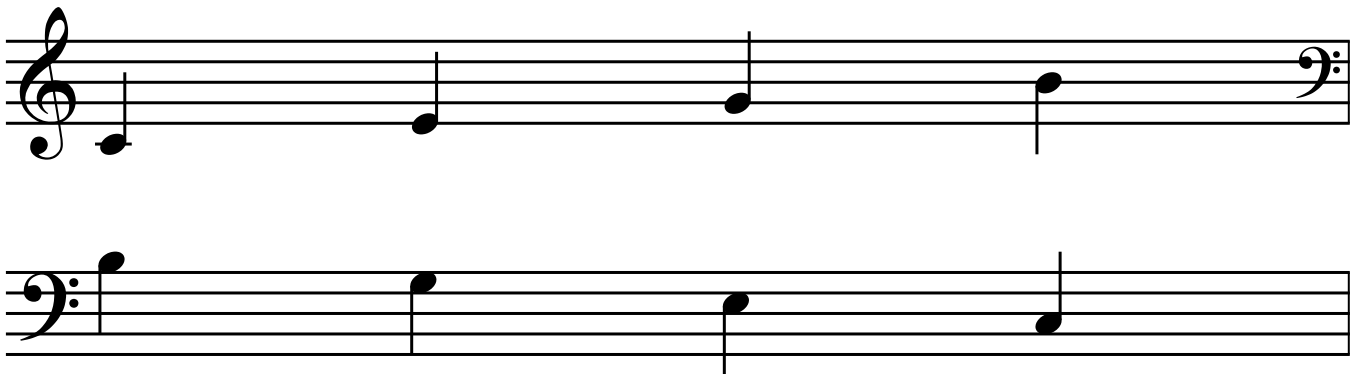

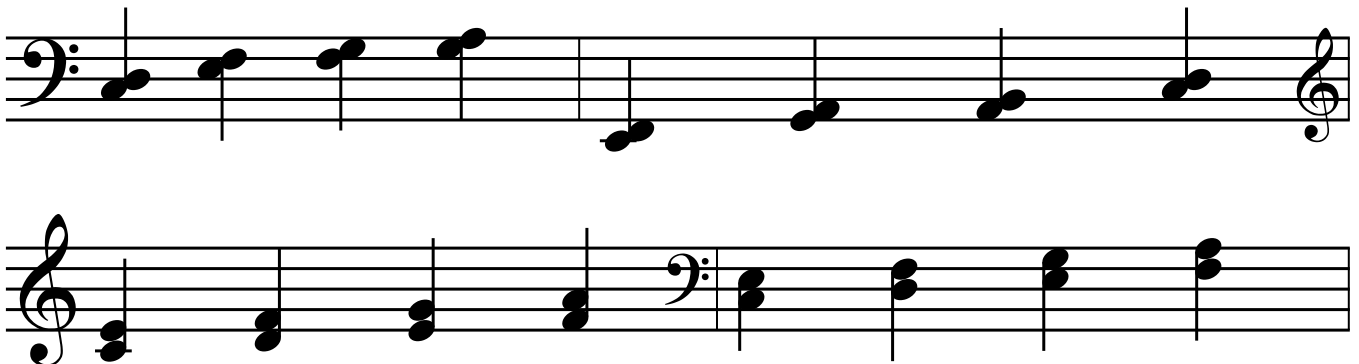
The distance between two notes is measured as "intervals." Stepwise motion, notes that move from a line to a space, or a space to a line, are 2nds. The interval between the two notes is a 2nd. The clef does not affect the interval.



A skip from a line to a line, or a space to a space is measured as a 3rd. The interval between the notes is a 3rd.

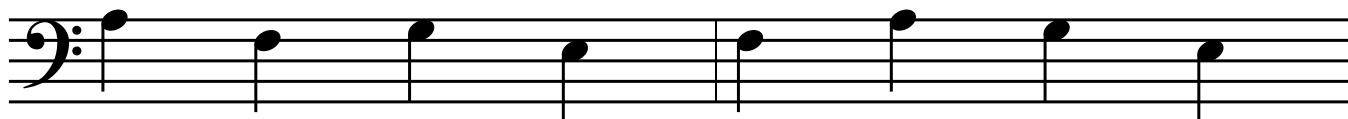


The above intervals ABOVE are melodic because they sound one at a time.
The intervals BELOW are harmonic because they sound at the same time.
