PORTFOLIO CONTENT

For Design Portfolio

This is where you determined the look of the show

- Photos of the Finished Work
- Renderings or Photo of model
- Technical Drawings (GP, Elevation)
- 1 or 2 Influential Research Photos
- Fabric Swatches

For Technical Portfolio

This is where you implemented someone's design

- Photos of Finished Work
- Photos of In Progress
- Drawings, Sketches, Notes of Solving Problems

For Stage Managers

- Copies (Never Originals)
- A Page At A Time (Note the whole book)
- Paperwork
 - Schedules
 - Sign in Sheets
 - Rehearsal Reports
 - Performance Reports
- Blocking Notes (W/ Key)
- Script Page or Two of Cues (W/ Key)

PORTFOLIO CONTENT

What NOT to Show

- Programs (Unless You Designed)
- T-Shirts (Unless You Designed)
- Tickets or Posters (Unless You...)

- Too Many Photos of One Show
- Scrap Book Stickers or Decorations
- Headshot
- Resume
- Photos of You and Your Friends
- Work That Isn't Yours

- Pencil Pouch (SM's)
- Sloppiness

Limit Or Pull Aside

- Cappie Awards
- Thespian Awards

For Display Board

- Think of Composition and Layout
- Most Impressive Photo is Largest
- Sneak Peak at Paperwork
- Reduce Sizes
- Name Should be Seen
