

Primary Healthcare Programs (programs are “different” and financially impact the health care system)

- Employer Plans
- Government Employer Plans
- Non-Profit Employer Plans
- Veteran’s Benefits
- Traditional Medicare – Parts A, B and C {Typically pay Healthcare Providers ~40% of Employer Plan Rates}
 - A – 80% of Hospital
 - B – 80% of Doctors, Clinics, etc. (no dental and basic vision only exam)
 - C – Optional Gap Coverage to cover the 20% not covered by A and B
 - Medicare Part D – Prescription Drugs
- Medicare Advantage – an alternative to Traditional Medicare
- Medicaid – Parts A, B, C and D {Typically pay Healthcare Providers ~20% of Employer Plan Rates}
 - A – Low Income Parents and Children
 - B – Children Only
 - C – Disabled
 - D – Low Income Adults
