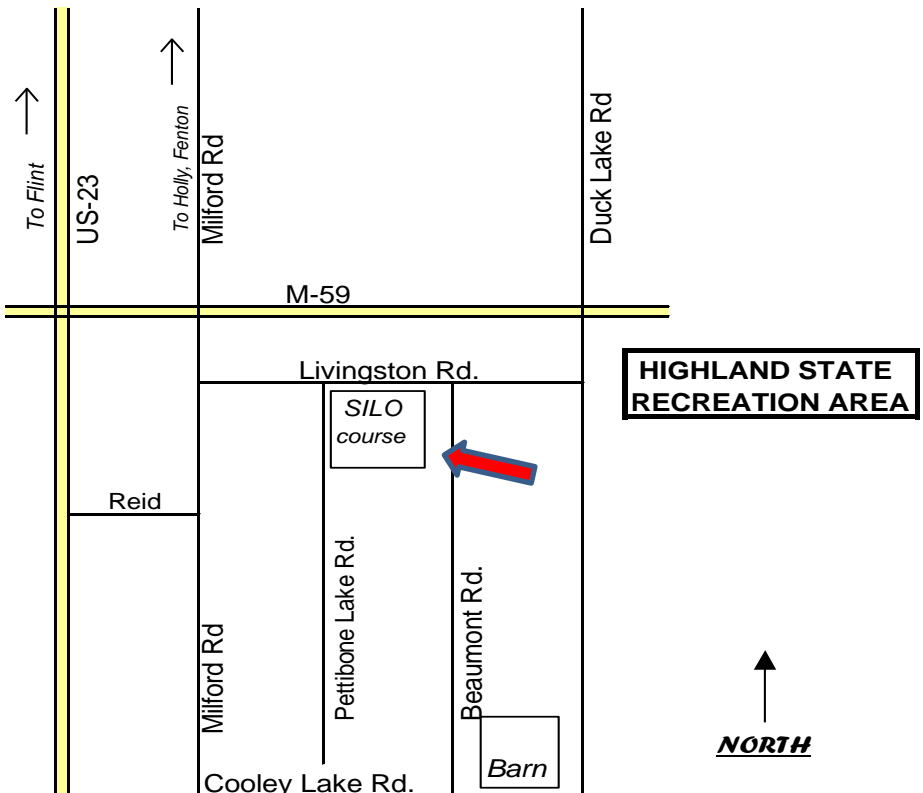

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Versatility Conformation judging is based on the present Standard which emphasizes the make and fit of all the individual parts and overall balance. You are not attempting to determine whether the dog is of championship caliber in conformation, but whether the specimen reflects the overall qualities of a pure-bred Irish Setter.

Dogs must be presented in a condition that will allow for the adequate evaluation of coat, color, structure and movement.

Dogs participating in this event need not be entered in one of the Field Events at this Hunting Test/Field Trial. ILP and PAL registered dogs may enter Versatility Tests.

## State of Michigan Field Trial Areas

### Highland Recreation Area

Use of the Field Trial Areas may not be more than 100 individuals. Each Club and person will be committed to ensuring safe use of the Field Trial Areas by implementing the following processes to stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

- No gatherings over 100 people will be allowed. Have a list of people who are present. 6-foot distancing will be practiced by all persons not from the same household. If less than 6 feet a mask must be worn.
- Before any person enters the Field Trial Area, individuals will make a self-evaluation for virus symptoms. Do you have a temperature exceeding 100.4, are you feeling sick and have you been exposed to anyone with COVID? Chairperson will ask those attending the event those 3 questions and all answers must be no. If you get a yes answer Reference response plan if any symptoms are detected.
- A daily cleaning will be performed on all common touch areas that members of the public could potentially come in contact with. The grills, fencing, seating, gates, pump handles, door handles and tables etc. must be sanitized often. The person who sanitizes tables etc. will wear disposable gloves while disinfecting. Sprays or wipes (Lysol, bleach etc.) can be used in the common contact areas.
- Hand sanitizer with a minimum of **60%** alcohol level will be available for everyone to use. Before touching any common touch points (gates, grills, fencing, doors/handles, pump handles, cooking tools, and tables etc.) hand sanitizing will be encouraged often with hand sanitizer. Sanitizing products will be provided by host club.
- Signs or placards will be posted on the bulletin boards which reference covid-19 health practice requirements in and around the structure.

#### **Covid-19 response plan if suspected or detected:**

- If any person experiences any symptoms or comes in contact with the COVID-19 VIRUS, the Event Chairperson will immediately notify the HFTGA association. The person will seek medical attention from their doctor and seek council of his professional advice and follow up on it.
- All common surfaces at the Field Trial Areas will be immediately cleaned and sanitized by a club member that is symptom free. (gates, pump handles, vault toilets handle/s inside and out, tables and any tools etc.
- After a 14-day self-quarantine for symptoms and using professional advice with a release from a medical professional, they will be able to resume entry to the Field Trial Area.
