The information will be included in the yearly RLA newsletter which is likely to be sent out in the spring.

Dennis created a schedule of RLA activities for 2020. The board also discussed different action items which need to take place in 2020.

Mark made a motion not to have the RLA meeting in December 2019, Dick second, the motion passed unanimously.

A motion to adjourn was made by Dick, Bob second, motion passed by unanimous vote. The meeting ended at 8:39 PM.
