Dear Mooring Permit Applicant:

Enclosed please find a 2020 Mooring Permit Application. Please read the following notes carefully:

Notes

The application fee is \$40.00 and is due April 1st.

Applications received after April 1st will incur a \$100.00 late fee.

Applications received after April 30th will be rejected. There will be no exceptions, including riparian permit holders for the year when a timely application is not received.

Applications that are not filled out completely will also be rejected.

ALL OF HAMBURG COVE is a 6mph “NO WAKE” area, this includes dinghies.

All mooring buoys must be a white buoy with a clearly visible horizontal blue band around the circumference of the buoy centered midway between the top of the buoy and the waterline. Any moorings that do not comply with this regulation may be removed at the owner's expense.

If you own a boat, please attach a copy of the most recent registration. If you do not, please attach a notarized statement stating that you do not own a vessel.

There continue to be complaints about the size of “raft ups” and **loud music**. Remember there are children around and please respect others. You are encouraged to share your mooring to make access to Hamburg Cove available to as many boaters as possible.

If you own waterfront property on Hamburg Cove you must include the map and lot number on the application.

Finally, I remind everyone that Hamburg Cove is a “no discharge” area. Some marinas have pump out facilities and there is a regional pump out boat that serves the area. Please make every effort to utilize these services for the benefit of all.

If you wish to receive a copy of Lyme's application regulations, please include a stamped, self-addressed envelope with your 2020 application.
