The supervisors are currently working on Kovach Road. Repairs to date have been done on Leslie, Lower Poland Mines, Kois, Creek, Lock, and Sit Still Roads.

CORRESPONDENCE:

Jim Rumble made a motion to make a \$300.00 donation to the Greensboro Youth Baseball Association. A donation sign will be placed in the outfield at Mon View Park and the donation hereafter will be \$150. per year. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Larry Rogerson and Jim Minor questioned Jim Rumble's number of hours worked in the fourth quarter of 2011. Jim responded that much of that overtime was spent bringing in materials around election day.
