Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the minutes from the June regular meeting. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

Bill clarified that DVJMA is responsible for fixing the roads in Penn Pitt disturbed by the new water lines, not the contractor. This had been reported incorrectly in a local newspaper.

CORRESPONDANCE: None

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

3 bids were opened for the advertised 1997 Chevrolet dump truck. Jesse Fox bid \$4,001.00, Kuis Excavating bid \$3,125.00, and Sulli Motors of Ambridge PA bid \$2,345.00. Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the bid from Jesse Fox. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed 2 yes votes (Bill and Lou) to 1 no vote (Jim).

Bill Monahan reported that a \$50.00 bid has been received by the Greene County Tax Claim Bureau for an acre of property in Poland Mines. The property has several abandoned structures on it, and the supervisors are concerned about the future cleanup of the property if it is sold. They continue to look into the matter.

Bill reported on some of the work that has been done in the Township during the month of June. Bill and Lou shoveled ditch lines, removed 2 downed trees and limbs, mowed and weed-eated several Township roads, did repair work to the equipment, emptied the recycle trailer 4 times, transported food for the food bank, and did crush and run work on 3 Township roads.

Jim Rumble questioned that Bill had blamed him last month for removing the plexi-glass from the John Deere tractor and causing the glass to break. Jim said the plexi-glass was removed because he could not see through it. Bill went into the shop and returned with the plexi-glass to show the audience that they could see him through it. Bill reported that the glass had been replaced at a cost of \$176.00.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Lou Kovach to adjourn the meeting at 9:10 am. The motion passed unanimously.
