Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the minutes from the February regular meeting. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS & PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill Monahan informed the audience that the Township has solicited bids to purchase a skid loader and a roller. Bids must be received by March 8. Special meetings will be scheduled for opening and awarding of any bids. The Township will also re-advertise the International for sale.

Bill Monahan made a motion to purchase a 1999 F550 Ford Super Duty truck from Jefferson Township for \$12,000. The price includes a plow and hopper spreader. Lou Kovach seconded the motion, and the

motion passed 2 votes to 1. Jim Rumble voted no because he does not like the motors in the Ford trucks.

Bill Monahan made a motion to give DVJMA \$10,000.00 in emergency funding, contingent upon review by our solicitor, Simon John. Lou Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously. The money will be used to replace 2000 feet of old water lines in Penn Pitt. Bill explained that the money will be used to purchase the pipe for the project and will be billed directly to the Township.

Jim Rumble questioned Bill Monahan about a fax he received after the February meeting. He accused Bill of passing out information after he had left the meeting, and he refused to name the person that had sent him the fax. The information was a copy of the DVJMA charter that was given only to Cindy Bailey after she asked the secretary for it. Bill informed Jim that he was tired of his false accusations.

Bob Kelly observed that the Township roads are in the best shape they have been in for years.

ADJOURNMENT:

A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Lou Kovach to adjourn the meeting at 9:35 am. The motion passed unanimously.
