Jim Rumble reminded that \$40,000 of grant money is reflected in the General Fund total.

Larry Lapana made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed.

CORRESPONDENCE:

A letter from Greensboro Borough was read requesting support for an extension of the bike trail on SR 2014. The supervisors agreed to give a letter of support, but to assume no financial or insurance responsibility for the extension.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

The supervisors set Trick or Treat in the Township for Saturday, October 30, 2010 from 5:00 – 7:00 pm. This will coincide with the time in the Borough.

A motion was made by Jim Rumble and seconded by Larry Lapana to pay the Township's portion of the Greensboro Fire and Ambulance Department's workers compensation from August 1, 2010 to August 1, 2011 at a cost of \$6,890.32. The motion passed unanimously.

The Board agreed to pay the Township share of the road maintenance to Cornerstone Care.

The Board laid Shane Lapana off effective October 4, 2010.

Jim Rumble said that he will get quotes, or bids if need be, to replace the doors and windows in the building. The cost will be covered by grant money.

Larry Lapana mentioned that Maple Ridge Road will be tarred and chipped. Two other roads will be oiled and the Township will get the stone to chip them.

Lou Kovach said an agreement will be made to start hauling ashes to the Township.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bob Watson asked that a hole in the cemetery road be fixed. Jim said that the supervisors are looking into getting a grant to have the road paved.

Jim Rumble reported that Attorney Hook is putting together a book containing all the resolutions and ordinances the Township has.

Larry Rogerson mentioned that Cecil Township has the best Marcellus Shale Drilling ordinance in existence.

Bob Watson complained about a wall in his store collapsing due to the sewage project. The supervisors said that they would mention this to the project manager.

ADJOURNMENT: The meeting was adjourned at 6:20 pm.
