Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Lou Kovach made a motion to approve the minutes from the September regular meeting. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Lou Kovach made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

CORRESPONDANCE: None

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill reported on work that has been done in the Township during the month of September. Bill and Lou dug additional ditch lines on Robena Road, delivered the recycle trailer to Greene Arc 5 times, dug ditch lines on Kovach Road, spread gravel and millings on Kovach Road, did the Food Bank, mowed roadsides

on Kovach, Maple Ridge, and Donham Roads, trimmed trees and mowed Creek Road, did shop work, spoke with several Township residents about Township-related issues, removed tree limbs from Robena Road, excavated topsoil from the interior of the newly-constructed ash building, added and compacted stone for the base of the building, topped the base with millings and graded the topsoil around the exterior of the building.

Bill Monahan made a motion to have trick or treat in the Township on Thursday, October 31, from 6:00 – 8:00 pm. Lou Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Bob Watson asked if Bill and Lou were passing out treats again this year at the Township Building. Bill replied that they were.

Minda Adams asked for 2 tractor signs to be placed on Township roads. Bill Monahan made a motion to purchase the signs. Lou Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Jack Keener asked about the repair of the outside lights on the Township Building. Bill responded that Bob Swaniger was following up on that problem.

Bob Watson asked about the repair of the caution lights at the crossroads. Bill responded that the insurance company is handling the problem and the work has been moving forward.

Scott Neighbors questioned a comment attributed to him in the August minutes. PSATS was contacted and advised that the minutes have already been approved by the Board of Supervisors and recorded.

Larry Rogerson asked about use of the CDBG funds. Bill responded that water is the major issue.

John Kroll from GeoKinetics addressed the audience about the proposed seismic survey in the Township. Mike Rudolph questioned him about the weight of the vibrator trucks and bridge restrictions. Bob Watson asked about cemetery disturbance. Ed Cech asked about water line damage. Several residents asked about the possibility of falls in old, abandoned mines and injuries to farm animals and equipment.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Lou Kovach to adjourn the meeting at 9:50 am. The motion passed unanimously.
