Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS: None

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the minutes from the July regular meeting. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Bill Monahan made a motion to send the Maletic House Committee Members to a Community Builders Workshop in Waynesburg at a cost of \$150.00 per member. Mike Rudolph seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously. The Supervisors hope to have more committee members and plan to purchase tables, chairs, a television, a Wii, a microwave, refrigerator, freezer, and various supplies for the house. Mike Rudolph added that they plan to get keys to all the committee members.

June Hellen asked about the possibility of moving the Food Bank from the Methodist Church to the Maletic House. Bill suggested she come down and look to see if it would be suitable. He added that the house is handicap-accessible.

Bill Monahan discussed the replacement of the 1999 Dodge with a used 1 ton truck with an extended cab which could be used to attend meetings, pick up parts, and replace a truck in a winter emergency. The Supervisors will start looking.

Trudi Monahan reported that the Maletic House Committee does not need officers or to keep minutes. They will report directly to the Supervisors. Kevin O'Malley is looking into the liability issues concerning the rental and usage of the building. Bill said the committee members plan to do some painting and power washing.

Jack Keener asked about a Fall Clean-Up Day. Mike Rudolph said it would be in early October, the same as last year.

Bob Kelly asked about the possibility of putting air conditioning in the skating rink at Mon View Park. Bill said he needed to contact the County about that issue.

Bill explained that 2 water line construction projects are planned in the Township. The first is a Cumberland Mine project and the second is a Keystone Clearwater Solutions project. Keystone has asked the Township for a heavy hauling permit for Creek, Maple Ridge, and Kovach roads. They plan to construct an above-ground, temporary water line. Bill explained that the Township cannot deny anyone access if they sign a legal road agreement.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Bill Monahan and seconded by Mike Rudolph to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 am. The motion passed unanimously.
