Bill Monahan made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Kevin O'Malley gave the following legal update: The Sewage Authority has an agreement with Greensboro Borough to proceed with the CDBG project. The Borough originally wanted control of the project, but has agreed to assign the project to the Authority with no conditions attached. Michael Manufacturing received the bid to do the investigative work on the stormwater issues which will satisfy the DEP violation notice.

Trudi Monahan gave the following Community Center update: The monthly Vendor Fair was held on July 7. Due to vacations, the vendor fair for August has been cancelled. Senior Day

was held on July 19. Jill Peth from Blueprints attended and explained the need for Meals on Wheels drivers. The next Senior Day will be held on August 16, at which time Michael Milinovich will speak on elder exploitation and financial planning. Blood pressure screenings will also be available from Amediasy. Brenda Stone was the winner of the TV raffle and Bobby Kelly was the winner of the Target gift card. Ed and Winnie Cech donated a bicycle which was also raffled off during the Cabbage Flats yard sale. A total of \$1204.25 was collected for the Senior Center during the month of July.

Bill Monahan reported that the supervisors are working with Walsh Equipment on acquiring a new truck for winter maintenance through the CoStars Program.

Bill Monahan made a motion to adopt Resolution #1-2018, the Greene County 2018 Hazard Mitigation Plan. Lou Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.

A discussion ensued about two complaints received by telephone this week regarding the tax collector, Rita King. A real estate closing was held up on July 31 due to a lack of tax certification. Bill Monahan made a motion to have Kevin O'Malley look into the Township's response to these complaints. Lou Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.
