Bill Monahan called the regular meeting to order at 9:00 am.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Bill Monahan made a motion to approve the minutes from the April regular meeting. Joe Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Joe Kovach made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report and to pay all bills. Bill Monahan seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The Supervisors are continuing to review the Township's Floodplain Maps. Maps are available for the public to review at the Township Building by appointment.

NEW BUSINESS AND PUBLIC COMMENT:

Kevin O'Malley gave the following legal update: Clean up work has begun on the Cox and Wolfe properties in Penn Pitt including pest control and dumpster trash clean up. Kevin suggested that the supervisors inspect the clean up work and take pictures before payments are made.

Bill Monahan made a motion to pass Resolution 1-2020, Property Tax Relief Provisions, enacted by Governor Wolf's Act 15 Proclamation. Joe Kovach seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously. A lengthy discussion ensued with Rita King, the township's tax collector, regarding ramifications of the tax relief (refunds, receipts). Kevin will look into the specifics of the provisions.

The supervisors announced that Spring Clean Up Day has been cancelled due to the covid-19 restrictions. A Fall Clean Up Day date will be decided on later.

Joe Kovach made a motion to give the Greensboro Fire Department an \$8000.00 donation. Lou Kovach seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made by Joe Kovach and seconded by Lou Kovach to adjourn the meeting at 9:50 am. The motion passed unanimously.
