TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-May 10th, 2021

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Martello, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Linden were present.
- First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None noted.
- Approval of Agenda-There was a Tomaszewski /Wiese motion to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Voucher Approval: There was a Tomaszewski/Wiese motion to approve the vouchers -with notice given to correct pay period dates on payroll checks. All Ayes. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for April 30th, 2021 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$331,610.25. April deposits of \$31,547.02 withdraws of \$11,648.82 with an ending balance of \$351,418.45. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to accept into records. All ayes. Motion carried. -Noted by Treasurer Allen that Surewood Forest still has not paid taxes and cannot renew liquor license until taxes are cleared by the bank first. All members in favor of no special meeting to discuss further.
- Minute's approval for the April 12th, 2021 regular town board meeting. There was a Tomaszewski/Martello motion to accept the minutes into the record. All ayes. Motion carried.
- Correspondence: none noted.

OLD BUSINESS

- Town Roads in need of repair- Chairman Wiese confirmed all projects are on the list to be completed when asphalt trucks are in the area- projected time frame by end of August.

NEW BUSINESS

- Opened Crack Sealing bids- with lowest responsible bid coming from Lakes Asphalt. Lakes confirmed completion by end of August 2021. Members to discuss further send notifications prior to next meeting.
- Per Annual April 20th meeting, Supervisor Tomaszewski agreed to get resale values for town owned property off Callahan Rd.
- Plowing of private roads- per Chairman Wiese, all private roads will be billed at same rate no matter how many times plowed. Private Road signs- Members agreed that Town of King is not responsible for the cost of new road signs.
- Driveway Permit Ordinance – Members discussed and agreed to have “galvanized steel” removed from culvert materials in current driveway permit ordinance.

- Adjourn: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to adjourn at 7:21pm.
