

**TOWN OF KING  
TOWN BOARD MEETING**

Approved Minutes

Monday-June 14th, 2021

- Chairman Wiese called the meeting to order at 7:00PM
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited
- Roll call of officers: Chairman Wiese, Supervisors Tomaszewski & Martello, Treasurer Allen & Clerk Linden were present.
- First public forum-brief concerns or questions: None noted.
- Approval of Agenda-There was a Tomaszewski /Martello motion to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- Voucher Approval: There was a Wiese/Tomaszewski motion to approve the vouchers. Motion carried.
- The Treasurer's report for May 28th, 2021 shows an opening balance at Tomahawk Community Bank of \$351,418.45. May deposits of \$4051.44 withdraws of \$14,673.09 with an ending balance of \$340,796.80. This balanced with the Clerk's records and the Bank. Tomaszewski/Wiese motioned to accept into records. Motion carried.
- Minute's approval for the May 10th, 2021 regular town board meeting. Wiese/Martello motioned to accept the minutes into record. Motion carried.
- Correspondence: none noted.

OLD BUSINESS

- Crack Sealing – Chairman Wiese confirmed notice was given to all who submitted bids.
- Callahan Rd- Tomaszewski reported, all property owners in area were notified of possible sale- will be turning it over to a real-estate agent to discuss further selling options.

NEW BUSINESS

- Liquor License – Board approved Licenses for Bottoms Up, Surewood Forest, Pine Pointe Resort and Campground, Organique Clinic and Rivers Edge Bar and Grill. New owners of Rivers Edge (Guppies Lakeside Grill) are also applying for a Liquor License- notice will be sent to paper.
  - Conditional Use Permit for Scott Mills – property owner on N10115 Sunny Point Rd requesting to keep a 30ft camper on site for over the allowed 60days. Motion was made to accept Lincoln county's recommendations. Lincoln County will advise further at their meeting July 8th.
  - Updates on Town Roads- Wiese advised we have to work around Lincoln County's time table, they will be in the area and estimate work to start approximately end of August beginning of September. Wiese hopes to address fixing Meyers Rd as well.
  - Update on past Covid Relief Funding- Per Tomaszewski, the CARE's funding required us to spend first and then ask for reimbursements. It was determined not to go further with past funding options. Per Clerk Linden- new funding is now being awarded to all municipalities in the state under the American Rescue Plan Act- Local Fiscal Relief Funds. Filing for this new allocation must be made by June 18, 2021 or dollars will go to other municipalities. Board agrees to go forward with filing and obtain more information as to what the Town of King can use this money for. More information and updates to be given at the next Town meeting.
