

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Eagle Learning Center students are expected to attend school on each scheduled school day for five (5) hours and 20 minutes. *Because we are a blended school, if a student is unable to attend for the full 5 hours and 20 minutes (on a particular day), they are expected to attend for a minimum of 4 hours plus an additional 1 hour and 20 minutes of GradPoint work is required.

When a student is absent, he/she will provide a note explaining the absence upon his/her return to school.

Each note should include:

- The date the note was written
- Full name of the student
- The date(s) the student was absent
- The reason for the absence
- Signature of parent/guardian if the student is under 18
- Telephone number where parent/guardian may be reached

A list of excused absences is included in the Student Handbook.

Students who do not bring a note will have their absence marked as an unexcused absence. Should a student accumulate unexcused absences, we will pursue the consequences outlined below.

The Eagle Learning Center is required by law to withdraw students who do not attend for 14 consecutive school days where the absences are unexcused.

A student of compulsory school age (under 18 years of age) is defined as a chronic truant if that child is absent from school (unexcused) for 7 or more consecutive school days; 10 or more school days in a month; or 15 or more school days in a year. **Ohio Revised Code, Section 2151.011**
