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Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3314.03(D)(2) specifies that the sponsor of the school must “monitor and evaluate the academic and fiscal performance, and the organization and operation of the community school on at least an annual basis.”

The Eagle Learning Center was generally compliant with the laws, rules, and regulations governing Ohio community schools. We will continue to monitor compliance with laws, rules and regulations throughout the school year. Academically, Eagle Learning Center is progressing towards compliance in academics. We will continue to provide technical assistance and monitoring of school academics.
