What is the GOOD Dirt Ride?

Formerly known as The Rwanda Ride or 50 Mile Ride, this event started back in 2006. It has evolved into **one of the largest mountain bike events in Southern California.**

We’ve raised over \$1,260,000 for our African non-profits in our first 13 events.

These funds are used to further the economic development of Rwanda and other african nations through initiatives based on the bicycle as a tool and symbol of hope.

OUR CHARITIES: QHUBEKA

Qhubeka moves people forward with bicycles.

Qhubeka is an Nguni word that means “to progress”, “to move forward”. Bicycles help people move forward. With a bicycle, a person can travel faster and further, and carry more.

People earn bicycles through these programmes:

- Learn-to-earn programmes for children
- Work-to-earn programmes for adults

Qhubeka also provides bicycles to first responders for disaster relief.

Qhubeka Vision

- Bicycles are an effective way to address the needs of school children in South Africa.
- 12 Million of the country’s 16 million school-going children walk to and from school. Some taking up to 4 hours round trip. With a Qhubeka bicycle, a child’s commute time is reduced by up to 75%.
- In Africa, a lack of access to transport means that people have to walk long distances to get to jobs, clinics, shops and opportunities.
- With a bicycle, people can travel four times faster than if they were walking. A bicycle also increases a person’s carrying capacity by five times and saves people money they would otherwise have had to spend on public transport.
- Bicycles make it easier for people to get to where they need to be, whether it’s a work opportunity, or visiting family, a clinic, or going to school.
