Rajesh Dave', MD, FACC, FSCAI

Dr. Rajesh Dave' is a recognized leader in cardiovascular intervention and a frequent speaker at global conferences. He is a pioneer in endovascular interventions, CLI, limb salvage and carotid artery stenting. Dr. Dave' serves as Chief Medical Executive of Holy Spirit Cardiovascular Institute and Chief of Cardiology and Director of Cardiac Catheterization Laboratories at The Ortenzio Heart Center and Holy Spirit Hospital in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania. Dr. Dave' serves as Editor-In-Chief of Heart International, Founder and Course Director of C3 Global Summit, an annual conference and exhibition now drawing 6,500+ attendees, and is a founding member of the American Bifurcation Club.



Tanveer Rab, MD, FACC, FSCAI

Emory University

Dr. Tanveer Rab is a Professor of Medicine at Emory University and an Interventional Cardiologist at Emory University Hospital in Atlanta. Practicing Interventional cardiology for 25 years with interest in complex coronary interventions including Left Main PCI, Coronary Bifurcation Intervention, High Risk PCI to include cardiogenic shock and OCT imaging, Dr. Rab is an advocate of risk stratifying patients after cardiac arrest for PCI procedures and has published an AHA manual for STEMI care: Mission Lifeline, Atlanta region. Dr. Rab currently serves as President of the American Bifurcation Club, the leadership committee of the Interventional Council of the American College of Cardiology, and chairs their CHIP Committee.



Vladimir Dzavik, MD, FRCPC, FACC, FAHA, FSCAI

Peter Munk Cardiac Centre, University Health Network

Dr. Džavík is Professor of Medicine at the University of Toronto and interventional cardiologist at the Peter Munk Cardiac Centre, University Health Network, with over 25 years of experience in the field. His research ranges from percutaneous coronary intervention during acute myocardial infarction to outcomes research in high-risk PCI populations, in particular complex bifurcation and CHIP subsets. He was PI of TOSCA-2, and the SHOCK-2 as well as co-PI of TOTAL, the trial of manual thrombectomy in patients undergoing primary PCI. Dr. Džavík is a member of the Editorial Boards of the American Heart Journal, Canadian Journal of Cardiology and Coronary Artery Disease, and has reviewed for the Lancet, Circulation, JACC, the European Heart Journal, JACC Interventions, Circulation Interventions, Eurointervention, Catheterization and Cardiovascular Intervention, and numerous other journals.
