Raj Dave', MD, FACC, FSCAI

Dr. Rajesh Dave' is a recognized leader in cardiovascular intervention and a frequent speaker at global conferences. He is a pioneer in endovascular interventions, CLI, limb salvage and carotid artery stenting. Dr. Dave' serves as Chief Medical Executive of Holy Spirit Cardiovascular Institute and Chief of Cardiology and Director of Cardiac Catheterization Laboratories at The Ortenzio Heart Center and Holy Spirit Hospital in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania. Dr. Dave' serves as Editor-In-Chief of Heart International, Founder and Course Director of C3 Global Summit, an annual conference and exhibition now drawing 6,500+ attendees, and is a founding member of the American Bifurcation Club.



Jeffrey W. Moses, MD, FSCAI

Columbia University Medical Center

Dr. Moses currently serves as Director of Interventional Cardiovascular Therapeutics at Columbia University Medical Center and as Director of Advanced Cardiac Interventions at St Francis Hospital and Heart Center in Roslyn, NY. Dr. Moses for his entire career has relentlessly pursued perfection in interventional vascular techniques and is a role model for generations to come in this ever-changing subspecialty of interventional cardiovascular medicine. He was C3 Lifetime Career Achievement award winner in 2010 besides numerous other awards in his career. An internationally recognized interventional cardiologist, Dr. Jeffrey W. Moses Professor of Medicine at Columbia University Medical Center has performed more than 18,000 interventional procedures, authored over 600 publications, and served as lead investigator for numerous national and international clinical studies that have demonstrated the effectiveness and safety of coronary stent placement.



Carlo Di Mario, MD, PhD, FESC, FACC, FSCAI, FRCP

Careggi University Hospital, Florence, Italy

Professor Carlo Di Mario was born in Modena, Italy and graduated in medicine, specializing in cardiology, from the University of Padua. He is a professor of cardiology at the University of Florence and director of structural interventional cardiology at the Careggi University Hospital, Florence, Italy. Prof Di Mario has served as secretary of the Working Group on Interventional Cardiology of the European Society of Cardiology (ESC) and was president of the European Association of Percutaneous Cardiovascular Interventions between 2009 and 2011. Between 2012 and 2014, he served as councilor of the ESC. He has been a member of the writing committee of many guidelines task forces of the ESC and is the first/last author or co-author of many expert consensus documents.
