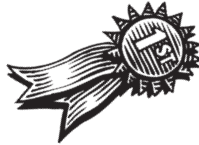

**NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES
FOR ALL MISCELLANEOUS & FSS BREEDS - EACH DAY**

NR2.09600. Exhibition Only - A class for registered dogs that are six months of age or over and of a breed for which a classification is offered in the premium list may be entered for Exhibition Only at the regular entry fee provided the dog has been awarded first prize in one of the classes at an Open Show held prior to the closing of entries of the show. The name and date of the show at which the dog was awarded the first prize must be stated on the entry form. A dog entered for Exhibition Only may not compete in any class at these shows and are not eligible for any prize offered.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This event is open to all dogs four (4) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. No Champions of Record may compete in an Open Show. Professional handlers or agents are only permitted to exhibit in FSS Open Shows if they are listed as an owner of record of the dog being exhibited. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

Dogs should be physically sound. No dog shall be judged if it is taped, bandaged, glued or has stitches anywhere including ears or tail in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registrable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the event grounds.

DOGS ENTERED ONLINE MUST ALSO SUBMIT A BENCHING REQUEST FORM.

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.
The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).
At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Norrbottenspets (Misc.).
At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on a table or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Mudik (Misc.).
Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Fees must accompany entries.** This Club and/or its Superintendent assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This Club and its Superintendent assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete.
2. **Admission Tickets:** One admission ticket will be provided for each dog with one owner and two tickets for each dog with two or more owners for each day the dog is entered.
3. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor** to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward nor of any agent of the show-giving Club to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring.
4. **No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.**
5. **The Superintendent or Club** will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these events is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
6. **Trophies and prizes** will be awarded in the judging rings to the persons exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging rings before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Superintendent's office advised at once in the event of any discrepancy.
7. **Exhibitors** are admonished to make themselves familiar with the rules of the A.K.C. and with the agreement on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list.
8. **Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 will be required for each first entry and \$3.00 each additional entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. An AKC Event Service Fee of \$2.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Open Show.** All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)
10. **Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.
11. **Unsightly and objectionable advertising matter** will not be allowed on the benches. The only **ADVERTISING** matter permitted are small signs, no larger than 11 x 14 inches, giving names and addresses of the kennels, the names of dogs, small signs stating that puppies or grown stock are for sale, or a plaque or emblem indicating the exhibitor's membership in recognized specialty clubs.
12. **Handbills, circulars or other Printed Material** may not be distributed or placed on the benches at these events.
13. **These are two Benched Shows;** compliance with "Rules Applying to Dog Shows", Chapter 13, Sections 1, 2, 3 & 4 is mandatory. No dogs will be excused prior to 5:00 P.M., Saturday and 4:30 P.M. Sunday. FOR DOGS ENTERED ONLY IN OBEDIENCE/AND OR RALLY: One hour after completion of all obedience and/or rally classes in which a dog is entered, the obedience and/or rally exhibitor may present themselves with proper legal identification [e.g. Driver's License] at the GGKC Show Office to obtain permission to be excused from the show. All other Benching Regulations apply. Crates and grooming will only be permitted within designated areas. Violators of this notice will be subject to action by the Event Committee.
14. **Under no circumstances will exhibitors be allowed to change their bench numbers.**
15. **All bench decorations must be flame retardant (by order of the State Fire Marshal).**
16. **No dog shall be on the bench** except in its natural show state. Curlers, rollers or any other artificial aids are not permitted.
17. **No dog is to be on the bench** in an enclosed crate (e.g. metal, wood, fiberglass). Any uncovered wire crates may be used if necessary.
18. **No food setups are permitted** in the Cow Palace without permission from the food concessionaire.
19. **Alcoholic beverages** are not permitted to be brought into the Cow Palace under the state of California Alcoholic Beverage Control Board Law.
20. **Class Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendents and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
21. **CRATES AND TABLES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE AISLES OR BENCHING SECTION OF THE SHOW. FURTHERMORE, THE HEIGHT OF BENCH DECORATIONS MAY BE NO MORE THAN 18" ABOVE THE BACK OF THE BENCH. THESE RULES REGARDING CRATES, TABLES, AND HEIGHT OF BENCH DECORATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
22. **A MB-F, Inc. Administrative Fee of \$2.00 will be withheld** from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
23. **Entries may be made online - www.infodog.com or through Dial-N-Entry® - (1-800) 334-8978 or (336) 379-9605. All entries received on line or through Dial-N-Entry will be benched individually unless a Benching Request Form is submitted by mail or by FAX at 1-800-746-3297.**
24. **When you provide a check as payment,** you authorize us to either use information from your check to make a one-time electronic fund transfer from your account or to process the payment as a check.
25. **As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entries

Entries not on official AKC Forms or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of official AKC entry forms are not acceptable.

Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

These are two one-day Benched Shows - All dogs must arrive Saturday no later than **10:00 A.M. and be benched until 5:00 P.M. All dogs must arrive Sunday no later than 10:00 A.M. and be benched until 4:30 P.M. See pages 7 & 8 for Benching Request Instructions.** Every dog that is entered and present must be at its assigned location during benching hours or in the exercise ring, or for a period of one hour prior to the time scheduled for its judging when it is being prepared for showing. Puppies need not be benched until after the judging of the breed classes for which it is entered, but **THEY MUST ENTER THE SHOW GROUNDS BEFORE 10:00 A.M. EACH DAY.** See AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 13, Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4. All Benching Regulations apply. Crates and grooming will only be permitted within designated areas. Violators of this notice will be subject to action by the Event Committee.

Unentered Dogs are not allowed at these events. Exhibitors bringing unentered dogs to sell will be subject to Event Committee action. SEE SHOW REGULATIONS FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

Important Notices

The State Fire Marshal requires that all bench decorations be treated with a flame retardant product and that the certificate or document that such products have been used be available at the events for review by the State Fire Marshal.

Additionally, the State Fire Marshal reminds all exhibitors that all aisles are to remain free of equipment and must be unobstructed by chests, tables or crates. Only collapsible stanchions and chairs will be allowed within the designated space in front of benching.

PUBLICATION RIGHTS: By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. The owner or agent can request an extension using the form found on the AKC Web site at <http://images.akc.org/pdf/extenap.pdf>.
