At Dental Arts Davis Square, we appreciate the trust you place in us and want to inform you about how we are addressing Coronavirus (COVID-19) and how we have implemented many changes to our regular business practices. As we look forward to continuing to meet your oral health needs, we would like to inform you of the many steps we have taken to ensure your safety in our practice.

We are closely monitoring events in our community and continuously updating our policies and protocols as a result of new information. Our office is following all recommended guidance from public health authorities, including best practices for hygiene, infection control and patient safety. We feel confident in our ability to continue seeing patients and providing care according to the tradition of quality care that you have come to expect and deserve from us.

Our highest priority is to keep all of our patients and staff as safe as possible. Therefore, at the recommendation of the CDC, we have been taking all staff and patient temperatures upon arrival. Additionally, our office will communicate with you prior to your appointment to ask a series of screening questions regarding your overall health. You will be asked these questions again when you arrive for your appointment.

As always, we adhere to the infection control guidelines set by the American Dental Association (ADA), the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). We understand the fear and uncertainty you may be feeling about coming for a dental appointment right now. To help set your mind at ease, we want to share some additional measures we've taken for everyone's safety.

You will notice the following changes when you arrive for your next appointment:

- Everyone in our office is required to wear a mask. You will be able to remove your mask as soon as your procedure begins.
- We will have hand sanitizer available that we will ask you to use as soon as you enter the building.
- Our reception area will no longer offer magazines, children's toys, etc., as these items are difficult to keep clean and disinfected.
- Appointments will be scheduled to allow for social distancing between patients. Please be aware that this may mean fewer available options for scheduling your appointment as we try to stagger patients, reduce waiting times, as well as to reduce the number of patients in the office at any one time.

If you have not been in recently for an appointment, our entire team at Dental Arts looks forward to welcoming you back! Please don't hesitate to reach out with any questions or concerns you may have about the steps we have taken to keep you safe in our offices. We are currently seeing patients for regular cleanings and for all routine procedures.
