



## Poster Art Contest Rules

Grades 2 through 6

Prize awarded to each grade level winner

1. The Poster Art must:

- a. Depict the eligible participant's interpretation of the theme, "Every Human Life is Beautiful". This can include the born or unborn.
- b. Be an original work of art in any of the following **2D** media/formats:

Colored Drawing: Colored pencil, pastels, crayon, conte, chalks, lead pencil, charcoal, pen and ink, oil pastel, watercolor, ink washes, acrylics, tempera, designer colors, gouache, inks and dyes.

Mixed Medium: The use of any mixture of two or more mediums, for example, watercolor with pencil or pen and ink with watercolor.

- c. Be no larger than a 22"x 28" poster
  - d. Be created in 2020
  - e. Contain no copyrighted material
  - f. Contain no threatening, offensive, or abusive words or art
  - g. Show a title for the art. Use limited wording on the art except for the title. Student's name cannot be seen on the artwork.
2. Artwork and online registration must be submitted by **Monday, November 2, 2020**. Register at [www.lifefirst.org](http://www.lifefirst.org) by clicking on "Student Activities" tab in navigation bar and then click "Poster Art Contest" and "Registration."

Submit digital photo file of your poster art using file type .jpg. Name your file using this protocol: 2020-art title.jpg (ex. 2020-In His Image.jpg). Email file to [posterartcontest@lifefirst.org](mailto:posterartcontest@lifefirst.org) by **November 2, 2020**.

3. Student must be in 2<sup>nd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grades. Student must be a resident of Texas in Montgomery, Harris, Fort Bend, Grimes, Walker, Liberty, Waller, San Jacinto, Brazoria, Galveston, Lavaca or Austin county.

4. One entry allowed per student per contest year.
5. Each poster will be evaluated on: originality, adherence to the theme and presentation of pro-life message, artistic ability, and overall effect. All decisions by the judges are final.

**Awards are as follows:**

2nd grade winner - \$50

3rd grade winner - \$50

4th grade winner - \$100

5th grade winner - \$100

6th grade winner - \$100

6. Winners will be notified shortly after the contest deadline. Before prize money is issued, winners must mail or deliver artwork to LifeFirst, P.O. Box 115, Magnolia, TX 77353. The winning posters will be displayed at the LifeFirst Dinner for Life. Artwork cannot be returned.
