

PCC WEEKLY PRAYER PLAN – June 10, 2020

Prayer application from Sunday's sermon, "[The Sign of Jonah](#)"

Read Luke 11:14-16. Some in the crowd were asking Jesus to show them a sign from heaven. They were testing him. Later, in verse 29, Jesus said, "This is a wicked generation. It asks for a sign, but none will be given it except the sign of Jonah."

Why did Jesus call the people wicked? By asking for more proof, they were showing they had not yet submitted to His supremacy. They wanted to believe on their own terms. They were skeptical of Him.

Are you also skeptical of Jesus' message? Are you seeking a sign beyond his death and resurrection?

- 1.) Read Matthew 12:38-41. What does this passage say about God's warning of judgement and how the people responded? How have you responded to Jesus death and resurrection?
- 2.) Read 1 Kings 10:9. How did the Queen of Sheba respond to Solomon's God? How did this contrast with the people testing Jesus? How have you responded to God's message of salvation?
- 3.) Read Luke 11:33-36. How does your response to God's message compare to the light entering your body? How does it compare to the light going out of your body to others?
- 4.) Read Luke 11:31-32. What or who is the scripture referring to when it says, "now something greater is here"? For similar references, also read Matthew 12:6, Heb 3:3, Matt 17:1-5.
- 5.) Read Colossians 1:15-18. Have you surrendered to the supremacy of Jesus Christ? Have you opened your heart to receive the light He gives? And does your life radiate that light to others?
