

PCC WEEKLY PRAYER PLAN – June 24, 2020

Prayer application from Sunday's sermon, "**RIDICULOUS DELIVERANCE**"

Read II Kings 6:24-7:2. God desires to refine superficiality, unbelief, and skepticism in our lives. He tests us whether we will use our own strength or wait for His RIDICULOUS DELIVERANCE.

Is the Lord desiring to refine something in you?

- 1.) Read Zachariah 13:9, Isaiah 48:10, and Job 23:10. Are you in a fire? Are you being tested?
- 2.) Read II Kings 6:30 - Do you have a superficial heart? Are you focused only on pleasure, on wanting happiness without the suffering? Do you blame God when bad things happen? Do you pretend to have faith or a Christian walk, but deep down you know it's not real?
- 3.) Read II Kings 6:31 - When given the choice to humble yourself before God, do you instead choose your own prideful actions? Are you fighting against God?
- 4.) Read II Kings 6:33-7:1 - Have you come to the end of your strength? Are you ready for deliverance?

The opposite of a superficial heart is a sincere heart.

- 1.) Read Psalm 25:3 - Is your hope in the Lord?
- 2.) Read Psalm 40:1 - Are you waiting patiently for His solution?
- 3.) Read Psalm 123:2 - Are you looking to the Lord - UNTIL - He shows His mercy? Remember, only through RIDICULOUS PERSISTENCE can we lay hold of the prize.

How to receive RIDICULOUS DELIVERANCE.

- 1.) Humble yourself before God. Repent. Only in your repentance will you experience His deliverance.
- 2.) Encourage yourself with scriptures about God's promises.
 - a. Read Luke 1:37, Matthew 19:26, Matthew 17:20. Is your situation impossible for God?
 - b. Read Matthew 6:25-34. Seek first HIS kingdom and righteousness, not your own.
 - c. Read the full Sermon on the Mount in Matthew chapters 5-7. Confess any text that contradicts your character.
- 3.) Wait for the Lord. ***FAITH WAITS!***

PRAYER PLAN

Pray for PCC fruitfulness

- 1.) Ask God to make us fertile ground so we can produce the fruit He wants us to produce
- 2.) Ask God to help us become RIDICULOUS in our faith and action
- 3.) Pray for disciple formation planning - that we would prepare ourselves well for harvest
- 4.) Pray for awakening/revival in our families, community, and nation

Pray for PCC congregation with various needs

- 1.) Proper spiritual perspective and prayerful action over national unrest and events
