

LOITERING
#63-06

An emergency ordinance to prohibit loitering, vagrancy, etc., and unlawful assembly without a permit.

Section 1: Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Pearl River, Louisiana in legal session convened that it shall be unlawful to assemble or parade without a permit.

Section 2: Be it further ordained that any person found violating this ordinance may be considered loitering or vagrant and held responsible under ordinances governing these misdemeanors.

Section 3: Be it further ordained that this ordinance shall become effective immediately after its passage and promulgation.

Section 4: Be it further ordained that anyone in violation of this law will be fined a maximum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or sixty (60) days in jail, or both.
