



**TOWN OF PEARL RIVER
COUNCIL MEETING
May 21, 2019 at 7:00 P.M.**

CALL TO ORDER:

The Council Meeting was held at the Pearl River Town Hall and so called to the order by Attorney Mathison at 7:00 p.m.

INVOCATION:

The Invocation was given by Alderman Bennett.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Alderman Lee.

ROLL CALL:

Present: Alderman Galloway, Walsh, McGregor, Lee, Bennett, Chief Sessions along with Attorney Mathison and Attorney Daigle. Absent: Mayor McQueen.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Attorney Mathison called for the approval of the minutes for April 16, 2019. Alderman Bennett made the motion to accept, seconded by Alderman Walsh. **All in favor. So moved.**

INTRODUCTION:

Attorney Mathison introduced Ordinance 21-05-19 (1) Prohibiting the Discharge of Firearms within the Town limits and introduced Ordinance 21-05-19 (2) The rezoning of Peach Street from R-3 to R-1-A. Attorney Mathison stated that both Ordinances would be open for discussion at the public hearing at the June 18, 2019 Council Meeting.

DISCUSSION:

- Attorney Mathison stated there were two discussions for the meeting. One was in reference to the fluoride in the drinking water. The resident's question was answered with "The Water We Drink Report" and the fact that the Town did not add fluoride to the drinking water. The second discussion was in reference to a building permit for "The Crossing Church".
- **Pastor Sam Husser of "The Crossing"** asked everyone to pray before the discussion. Pastor Husser told how he and the Church obtained the ten (10) modular buildings. He proceeded to explain to the Council the difference between a modular home that can only withstand 80 miles per hour of wind in comparison to the modular commercial buildings he
