³SPWRAP has established a minimum annual assessment of \$50. Also, a member whose annual assessment is \$200 or less has the option of making a one-time assessment payment that is thirteen times (the length of the Program Extension increment) their calculated annual assessment. If a member's calculated annual assessment is \$2, thirteen times that amount would be \$26. However, since the minimum assessment is \$50, the member pays \$50 one time and is covered for the First Increment Extension of the Program. If a member's calculated annual assessment is \$6, the member can either pay \$50 each year, or make a one-time assessment payment of \$78 (\$6 x 13). Members should consider the possible benefits of making a one-time payment.

Disclaimer: This reporting form may be revised in the future to reflect information needed to comply with Program requirements. Entities electing to join after 2007 will be required to pay the assessment for the year they join the program. In addition, the new member must pay assessments for all prior years of the program, plus 4% interest, compounded annually.
