¹The Jackson County Water Conservancy District will review and authorize the water related activity associated with the proposed oil & gas well development in order to assure that the total North Platte Baseline entitlement will not be exceeded and will make the official determination of whether or not to approve any request to provide coverage under the North Platte entitlement.

SPWRAP will not process any application that has not received this authorization (signature) by the Jackson County Water Conservancy District prior to submitting this application to SPWRAP.

²SPWRAP has established a minimum annual assessment of \$50. If your entity did not have well drilling "occurrences" back to 2007, you are required to pay the \$50 minimum payment for each year back to 2007 and up to the year of the entities first well "occurrence." Annual assessments are required from that point forward to remain a member in good standing with SPWRAP.

³New Class I-3 Industrial members are required to pay an assessment for all wells previously drilled/fracked, including any existing wells that were refracked, from January 1, 2007 up to the year they join SPWRAP. This information must be entered into the Class I-3 "Supplemental" Assessment form which is available on-line at www.COSPWRAP.org
