With 69 total bands, many of them Grand Nationals Finalists and Semi-Finalists, this competition was heavily competitive, with only 14 bands proceeding to finals. I am happy to tell you that this did not affect us at all, and every single one of us gave everything we had on the field. I truly believe that that performance was the best we had ever done this season, and I think everyone was satisfied with how we performed. However, at the prelims awards, we found out that we did not make it into finals, falling out by less than a point difference. After we had changed out of our uniforms, we returned to the stadium to watch the finals performance. Every single one of the bands left a lasting impact on us, whether it be learning how the top bands in the country performs or how Franklin treats other bands. Even though we did not make finals, there were many things to be learned from this event, and I hope it has motivated the band to work and focus more than ever before in the last two weeks of the season. Every year, these last weeks is when the band is the most focused and we have amazing rehearsals almost every day. I am glad we have started early this year with Thursday and Friday last week, and I hope the energy and focus continues into this week and the next with the Community Performance and Contest of Champions happening on the two remaining Saturdays of the season.

On September 19 Riq Lazarus was on tour in California with his work crew and their band. While traveling after a show a tragic accident occurred Riq seriously injured. After a time in the hospital in CA and a safe medic flight home, the Lazarus family is ready for our support! 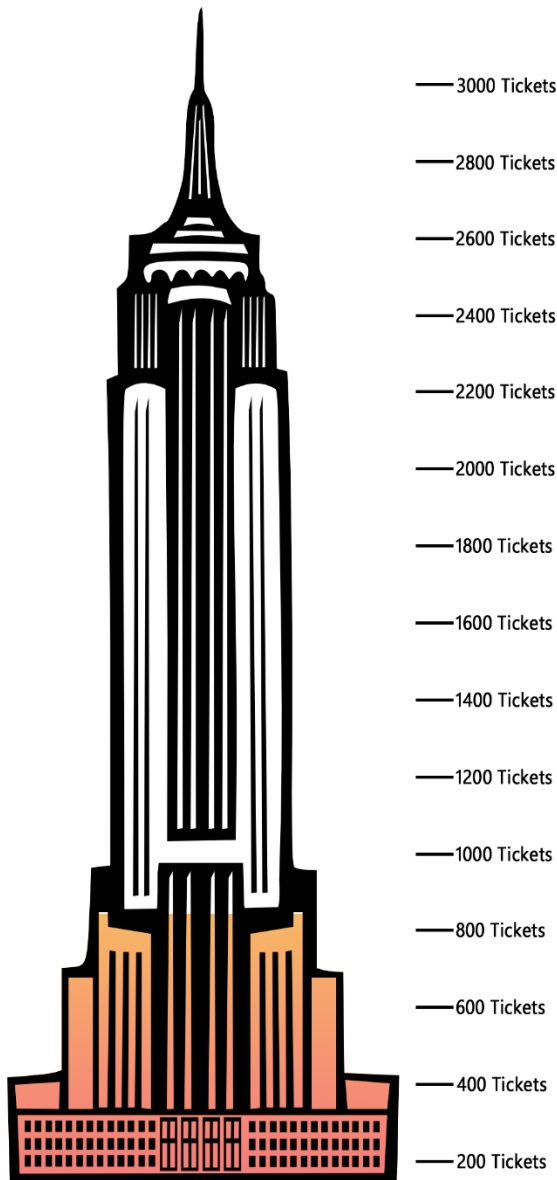
