I want to thank everyone for an incredible Sonic Boom! 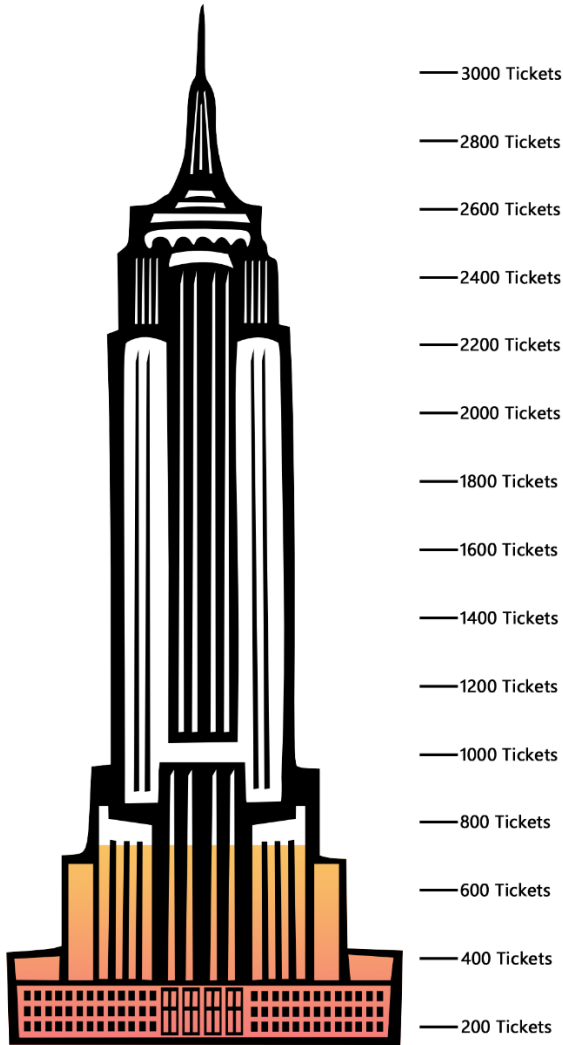
As we are beginning to attend competitions, our expenses increase and we need to make sure all payments are submitted so that our students can continue to receive the best experience possible!
