FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What type of organization is eligible to apply?

This opportunity is for CultureSource member organizations, which are 501c3 nonprofit organizations that have arts and culture as their primary missions.

Where do the organizations have to be located?

CultureSource serves the seven counties of Southeast Michigan. Those counties include Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair, Washtenaw, and Wayne.

How much are the grants?

There will be sixteen, \$5,000 grants.

What kind of technological investments does this grant opportunity aim to fund?

Proposed technological investments must be connected to the online work of the organization (programmatic, administrative, etc.). Successful applications will detail why their proposed technologies or equipment are sustainable investments for the long-term future of the organization's arts and culture work.

Do I need to attach a budget?

No budget attachment is required but the cost of the equipment or technology you plan to purchase, and the number of units, is information you will need to provide in one of the application questions.

Will I be able to start my application and continue at a later date?

Yes, you will be able to save and resume your application in Formstack.

When is the application due?

Applications for the Digital Access for the Arts Program Funding Opportunity are due by **5:00 p.m. March 1, 2021.**

When will funding go out?

It is anticipated that decisions will be made March 15, 2021, with funds distributed by late-March 2021.
