## Class Specifications

**Leadline** – Open to riders of all disciplines age 7 years of age or under who have never competed in any riding class other than leadline.

**Walk Trot Equitation & Pleasure** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines who have never competed in any class requiring a canter or lope. Classes to be judged at the walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. May be asked to back.

**Open Equitation & Pleasure** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines. Classes to be judged at the walk, trot/jog and canter/lope both ways of the ring. May be asked to back.

**Open Equitation Pattern** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines. Class to be judged at the walk, trot/jog and canter/lope, pattern to be posted prior to the start of the class.

**Open Hunter Under Saddle** – Open to riders of all ages. Class to be judged at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to extend gaits, hand gallop and/or back. To be judged on horse's ease and way of going.

**Walk/Trot Ground Poles** – Open to riders of all ages who have not competed in any class requiring a canter, lope or jumping. Course to include no more than eight (8) but no less than four (4) ground poles, to be posted prior to the start of the class.

**WTC Ground Poles** – Open to riders of all ages who have not competed in any class requiring jumping. To be shown over 4 to 8 ground poles, course to be posted prior to the start of the class.

**Walk/Trot Crossrails** – Fence height not to exceed 18" pen to riders of all ages who have not competed in any class requiring a canter, lope or fences exceeding 18". To be shown over 4 to 8 fences, course to be posted prior to the start of the class.

**WTC Crossrails** – Fence height not to exceed 18". Open to riders of all ages who have not competed in any class requiring jumping over 18". To be shown over 4 to 8 fences, course to be posted prior to the start of the class.

**Open Equitation Over Fences** – Fence height not to exceed 2'3". Open to riders of all ages. To be shown over 6 to 8 fences, course to be posted prior to the start of the class. To be judged on rider's position over fences.

**Open Hunter Over Fences** – Fence height not to exceed 2’3”. Open to riders of all ages. To be shown over 6 to 8 fences, course to be posted prior to the start of the class. To be judged on horse’s way of going.

**Jumpers** – Fences not to exceed 2’6”. Open to riders of all ages. To be shown over 6 to 10 fences, courses to be posted prior to the start of the class. Electronic timers to be used.

**Walk/Trot Gymkhana** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines who have never competed in any class requiring a canter or lope. Electronic timers to be used.

**Open Gymkhana** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines. Electronic timers to be used.

**Jackpot Gymkhana** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines. Electronic timers to be used. Payout to be 50% of class entries, respectively, winner take all.

**Walk/Trot Trail** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines who have never competed in any class requiring a canter or lope. To be shown through a course of 8 to 10 obstacles, to be posted prior to the start of the show.

**Open Trail** – Open to riders of all ages and disciplines. To be shown through a course of 8 to 10 obstacles, to be posted prior to the start of the show.

**Western Dressage** – Open to riders of all ages. Times to be posted prior to the start of the show, please arrive early for your test, there will be no gate holds. Tests available at <http://westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-tests/>
