

**GALLATIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT**  
**June 13, 2019**

The meeting of the Gallatin County Fiscal Court was called to order by Judge Ryan Morris on June 13, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. at the Gallatin County Senior Center, Warsaw, Kentucky. Magistrates present were Ethan Moore, Donnie Sullivan and Joel Shinkle. County Attorney John G. Wright was also present. Everyone stood for the pledge of allegiance.

**Minutes:** Joel Shinkle made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting of May 9, 2019. Donnie Sullivan seconded. All ayes.

**Recognition of Audience:** Judge Morris asked if anyone would like to address the court. Daria Kelleher was recognized. She asked why they were not allowed in the animal shelter, why it looks like it does, and what's happening with the dogs. Marian Dunkerley was recognized. She congratulated Magistrate Sullivan on a job well done on the 21<sup>st</sup> Hansel Sullivan Memorial Pull held at the Fairgrounds on May 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup>.
