

RESOLUTION NUMBER 7920-
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2008-01


WHEREAS, Gallatin County Fiscal Court has discussed and considered amending the Gallatin County Flood Plain Ordinance that was adopted in its most current form in December 2017;


Whereas, considers that the local Flood Plain ordinance includes two additional feet about the base flood elevation as an additional cushion in time of flood and this additional footage is referred to as 'freeboard' ; and

WHEREAS, Gallatin Fiscal Court believes it is in the best interest of Gallatin County and its residents to remove the additional two feet of "freeboard" and get in compliance with the current standards as established by the Commonwealth of Kentucky,

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED THAT on March 12, 2020, The Gallatin County Fiscal Court passed an ordinance for first reading to amend the Floodplain Ordinance. It removed the language requiring a 2 foot freeboard. The language now only refers to the level of the base flood elevation, putting it in line with the state statutes and regulations. The second reading of said ordinance was passed on July 9, 2020 and this ordinance shall be effective upon publication
