



The parishioners of Ebbing Spring contributed to the Moores after BKM. Washington County exempted William from taxes on 17Apr1782. Washington County continued their pension to Moore on 15Apr1783. Gov. Edmond Randolph signed a state pension to Moore on 20Dec1787 @ £15/annum retroactive to 01Jan1786. Gov Beverly Randolph added £3/annum to Moore's pension 29Oct1789. Letter in federal pension file S24312 indicate that Moore received a federal pension in 1816 for which \$8/mo was the ordinary grant to disabled private soldiers.
