



Private John Gebie is not listed on the 1909 monument bronze plaque of patriot casualties at Kings Mountain.

Bobby Gilmer Moss in *The Patriots at Kings Mountain* lists payment by South Carolina to John Gebie (Gribey), wounded at Kings Mountain. Expenditures by the state are recorded in audited accounts such as AA274 retained on microfilm in state archives at Columbia and the museum at McColvey Center in York SC.

Payment by the state five years after the battle indicates a serious wound with ongoing disability
