

William Bivins

William Bivins was born 14Apr1748 in Summerset MD. William Bivins first served in the Delaware militia under Lt. Conway, Captain Nathaniel Mitchel and Colonel Mitchel patrolling around Delaware Bay and guarding public stores. He later enlisted at Blackford Town, Sussex County DL in Colonel Mitchel's Regiment, Delaware troops and was commissioned as ensign. Bivins was in the Battle at Cowpens 17Jan1781 where he was wounded by a ball in the right hip.

While living in Montgomery County IN Sep1834 (FPA R876), William applied for a pension. He testified that his records were destroyed at Lawrence County OH about 1821 when his residence burned.
