

Nathaniel Dickison (FPA S3289)

On 24Jan1833 in Perry County TN, **Nathaniel Dickison** applied for a pension. In his deposition he stated that he was born 06Oct1756 in Bedford County VA. He enlisted in 1780 in the Surry County North Carolina militia under Captain Joseph Cloud and Colonel Tipton as a substitute for Frederick Holt. In a second tour as a volunteer, he was elected lieutenant. The company deployed to Join Ganeral Daniel Morgan in South Carolina. At the Battle of the **Cowpens**, Dickison was wounded in his left groin by a musket ball “he being **so badly wounded** that to this day he is a cripple.”

Nathaniel lived in the portion of Surry County which became Stokes County until after the War, then moved to Tennessee. After residences in Davidson and Robertson counties, he settled at Lick Creek in Perry County.
