

William Dickson

On 11Dec1850, in Monroe County TN court, 80 year old Sarah Bayless, widow of William Dickson, applied for a widow's pension. She had information from the South Carolina controller detailing William Dickson's service dates, commanders, and payments.

Dickson was deployed to battles at Kettle Creek, Cowpens, and Ninety Six among lesser engagements. One deployment was 111 days under Captain Samuel Otterson in Colonel Thomas Brandon's militia. In one battle, Dickson was shot in the mouth.

William Dickson married Sarah Frank in Abbeville District 06Jan1777. They moved to Tennessee in 1808. He died in Jul1824.
