

Samuel Hogg

Samuel Hogg applied for a pension (FPA W7762) on 15Sep1836, in Greene County GA, at age 79. He described eight months of militia service under Captain David Baldwin in Ninety Six District beginning in Jul1777. He received a pension rated on 8 months service.

Henry Stewart testified in Taliferro County, GA in 1846 that Samuel Hogg entered service in Spartanburg, SC and that Hogg was wounded in the shoulder at the Battle of the Cowpens under Colonel Pickens. He also stated that Hogg married Eleanor Ray after he moved to Georgia. Stewart described Hogg as a devout Presbyterian. But in his own pension declaration, **Henry Stewart did not say the he, himself was at Cowpens or Spartanburg.**
